- The cost for a 2023 Fall Semester Parking Permit is free for enrolled students. Students must have an active student ID number to receive a 2023 Fall Semester Parking Permit at no cost, but all vehicles must be registered. Any permit request submitted after August 18 will not be mailed out, and permits will have to be picked up at the Campus Safety Office.
- A grace period for parking permit enforcement will be in effect until September 1, 2023. Enforcement
 of parking permits for the 2023 fall semester will begin September 4, 2023.
